What used to be a shocking number of interviews to have in one day has become the new norm. In the new SKCOE - we are able to facilitate up to 3 interviews at a time, decreasing the wait time for children and their families; decreasing revictimization.

Demand for Out-of-Town Court Support

The demand for supports outside the CACAC has dramatically grown - taking away the available support for those here at the Centre. Inside the new building, we now have our own CCTV room where Quinn & his handler can support the child/children right here. This allows for the wholistic purpose of a CAC to take place - to be the one, safe, child-minded location the child goes to be supported. This also means for less travel time for both the Advocacy Team & RCMP = more time for children/interviews at the Centre.
